Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) is a major driver of economic growth and an important source of non-debt finance for the economic development of India. It has been the endeavor of the Government to put in place an enabling and investor friendly FDI policy. Measures taken by the Government on the fronts of FDI policy reforms, investment facilitation and ease of doing business have resulted in increased FDI inflows into the country.

During April to August, 2020, total FDI inflow of US\$ 35.73 billion is received. It is the highest ever for first 5 months of a financial year and 13% higher as compared to first five months of 2019-20 (US\$ 31.60 billion). More details can be accessed from the News Section.

Between April 2020 and August 2020, India received a cumulative inflow of \$35.73 billion of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) and this is the highest ever for the first five months of a financial year, the Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry said. Read more

Infosys hits Rs. 5 trillion (US\$ 68 billion) in market cap

Currently, with a market capitalisation of around Rs. 15.43 trillion (US\$ 210 billion), Reliance Industries is India's most valued business, followed by TCS and HDFC Bank at around Rs. 10.42 trillion (US\$ 140 billion) and Rs. 6.62 trillion (US\$ 90.30 billion), respectively. Infosys is now the 5th Indian company to cross Rs 5 trillion. Read more

Exports rose by 5.99% in September 2020 for the first time in seven months, boosted by products such as pharmaceuticals and engineering goods. Read more

Indian exports to US, China on rise in 2020

According to data collected from the Centre, India's exports to the USA amounted to USD 5.1 billion in September 2020, 15.5% more than the figures for the corresponding month (USD 4.4 billion) in 2019. In addition, imports from the United States decreased by a substantial 34.3% to USD 1.8 billion in September 2020, compared to USD 2.8 billion in September 2019. Read more
