India is undergoing the second wave of Corona virus and active efforts are underway to keep the supply of medicines and essential medical equipment flowing smoothly, including of oxygen supplies. We are thankful to all for the support being received from the Netherlands.

India-EU Leaders' Meeting: At the invitation of the President of the European Council Mr Charles Michel, Prime Minister of India Mr Narendra Modi participated virtually at the India-EU Leaders' Meeting on 8 May 2021. The meeting was held in a hybrid format.

They exchanged views on three key thematic areas: i) foreign policy and security; ii) COVID-19, climate and environment; and iii) trade, connectivity and technology. They discussed forging closer cooperation on combating the COVID-19 pandemic and economic recovery, tackling climate change, and reforming multilateral institutions. India appreciated the prompt assistance provided by the EU and its member states to combat its second COVID wave. The leaders welcomed the decision to resume negotiations for balanced and comprehensive free trade and investment agreements. More details can be read here.

Sharp increase in merchandise exports from India 2021

India's merchandise exports in April 2021 was USD 30.21 billion, an increase of 197.03% over USD 10.17 billion in April 2020 and an increase of 16.03% over USD 26.04 billion in April 2019. Major commodity groups of export showing positive growth in April 2021 over April 2019 include Iron ore (219.55%), Other cereals (206.43%), Oil meals (86.59%), Jute mfg. Including floor covering (66.19%), Rice (49.45%), Cereal preparations and miscellaneous processed item (40.34%), Electronic Goods (35.81%).

# PLI Scheme on Solar PV Modules

Bidders eligible for the scheme:

- Single company
- Joint Venture/consortium of more than one company, in which case a partner/company will be allowed to tie up their manufacturing capacity (of any stage) with another partner/company for one bid only
- The selection of the beneficiaries will be made by the bucket filling method keeping in view the overall PLI limit of INR 4,500 Cr
- The bidder with the highest marks/inter se position will get the PLI amount for 5 years followed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> bidder and so on till the PLI amount is exhausted

## Solar PLI scheme to benefit 8-13 pc of incremental panels demand till FY30: Report

According to India Ratings and Research (Ind-Ra), the solar production-linked insurance (PLI) scheme will support 8-13% of photovoltaic energy plant requirements until 2029-30 and will help grow 20 gigawatts (GW) of energy in the next five years. Read more




