





The Indian Food Processing Sector at a Glance



Attracted USD 6.19 billion FDI equity inflow during April 2014 to March 2023

Contributes to 8.04% GVA in manufacturing and 9.66% in Agriculture

Supportive Policy Environment

Business & Regulatory Reforms:

- 100% FDI permitted in Food Processing, Retails trading including e-commerce
- 40,000+ compliances reduced
- The National Single Window portal hosts applications for approvals from 31 Central Departments and 22 State Governments
- Agro-Processing included in priority sector lending – loans upto INR 100 crore per borrower

Tax Reforms:

- One of the lowest corporate tax globally at 15% for new businesses
- Remission of duties and taxes incurred on exports from India
- 100% exemption of Income Tax on profits and gains for new Food Processing Units for the initial five assessment years

Other Reforms:

- FSSAI Shift from product-by-product approval to an ingredient and additive-based approval process
- Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and small Enterprises (CGTMSE)

World Food India 2023

In view of 2023 being estiablished as International Year of Millets and to bring global food processing industry together, the Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Government of India organised the 2nd edition of International Mega Food Event "World Food India 2023" from 3rd – 5th November 2023 at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. The event was one of the biggest congregation of government departments & dignitaries, global investors and business leaders of major global and domestic agrifood companies in the country.

The event was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi on 3rd November 2023 at the Plenary Hall of Bharat Mandapam. The valedictory session of 'World Food India 2023' event, concluded on 5th November and was graced by the esteemed presence of the Hon'ble President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu.
