

BIRTH CERTIFICATE BASED ON INDIAN PASSPORT (BCP) HOW TO APPLY

Type of Document	Birth Certificate on the basis Indian Passport can be issued to Indian passport holders and Identity Certificate (IC) Holders, respectively based on passport and IC. Applicants should mention the purpose for which this birth certificate will be used.
How to apply	<p>1.Fill up the Miscellaneous form online.</p> <p>2. All the applicants seeking BCP services should see the below checklist for details:</p> <p>Please visit BCP check list Link</p> <p>3. Take Print-out of the online filled in application form. The form should be duly signed, photographs and necessary documents.</p> <p>4. Book an appointment (link)</p> <p>5. Book prepaid airway bill DHL Express service in the Netherlands for receiving processed documents. This should be submitted along with an A4 size self-addressed envelope</p> <p>6. Submit application for BCP alongwith necessary documents and prepaid A4 size self-addressed envelope at Embassy of India in The Hague (Ornajestraat 12, 2514 JB, The Hague).</p>

Processing Time	05 to 07 days dispatch by courier only, no counter collection at the Embassy.

BIRTH CERTIFICATE BASED ON INDIAN PASSPORT (BCP) FAQs

Q What does mean Birth Certificate based on Passport?

A: A document issued to the Indian national, based on the current Passport he holds.

Q. Can it be issued to the holder of Identity Certificate issued by the Indian Government?

A : Yes. He/ She may apply, following same process.

Q: Can OCI card holder apply for BCP?

A : No, Only Indian national can apply for BCP.
