

ENTRY VISA

THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY VISAS:

- Applicants applying on dependent or spouse basis must be married. Civil partnership is not recognised by the Indian Government and hence such applicants must apply for a Tourist visa.
- Dependents accompanying a spouse or parent holding a Business or Employment visa must apply for a Business Dependent Visa or Employment Dependent Visa – documents required see on the relevant checklist

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR AN ENTRY VISA

- 1 Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months (or for the validity requested, if greater) and having at least 2 blank visa pages ☐
- 2 Two photographs conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our website (5 cm * 5 cm) **Photographs and Photocopy facility is not available in Embassy.** ☐
- 3 An Indian Government visa application form duly filled in online and signed on pages 1 and 2 ☐

- 4 Prepaid self-addressed Envelope (mandatory) for return of Ready Passport or documents must be provided with the application. ☐
- 5 Additional documents mentioned below as per your case ☐

LIST OF ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

If the applicant has previously held Indian nationality (one of the below documents)

- A copy of their “Surrender Certificate” (if you do not have this you may refer to our website for details) ☐
- A copy of their “Renunciation Certificate” (if you do not have this you may refer to our website for details) ☐
- A copy of their “Deemed Surrender Certificate” (if you do not have this you may refer to our website for details) ☐
- Declaration of the status of the Indian passport and Uittreksel showing the date of obtaining foreign nationality ☐

If the applicant is the spouse/child of an Indian national or person who previously held Indian nationality

- Spouse: Marriage certificate copy with Apostille stamp ☐
- Minor: Birth certificate, both parents passport copies and a “No objection letter”, signed by both parent ☐
- One of the documents mentioned above in the section “*If the applicant has previously held Indian nationality*” ☐

If the applicant is accompanying a parent or spouse holding a PIO or OCI card

- Copy of PIO card or OCI card of parent or spouse ☐
- Spouse: Marriage certificate copy with Apostille stamp ☐
- Minor: Birth certificate, both parents passport copies and a “No objection letter”, signed by both parent ☐

If the applicant wishes to join the Auroville community

- Official invitation letter issued by the Secretary of Auroville. This document must be provided in its original sealed envelope ☐

If the applicant owns a property and intends to reside in India

- Copy of permission letter from Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to acquire the property in India ☐
- Copy of proof of ownership/acquisition of property in India ☐
- Copy of registration of the property with the concerned authority in India ☐

If the applicant is a minor

- Copy of the birth certificate or family Uittreksel showing the names of both parents ☐
- Copy of each parent’s passport and residence card (if applicable) ☐
- No Objection certificate for a minor to travel signed by both parents (see Download Form section on our website) ☐

If the applicant is not holding a Dutch passport

- Recent Uittreksel from the gemeente or residence proof in the Netherlands including date of registration in the Netherlands ☐
- Residence card showing the date of registration in the Netherlands ☐
- In case the applicant has not been a resident in the Netherlands for more than 2 years the [Telex Form](#) is required (see ☐

If the applicant is having dual nationality

Declaration of holding a second passport ☐

In case there is a valid Indian visa in the second passport both passports must be submitted in order to cancel the existing visa. ☐

In case the applicant is a Dutch national of Suriname origin (maximum 6th generation)

Duly Apostilled Certificate issued from Ministry of Home Affairs of Government of Suriname regarding Indian origin of
- ancestors (restricted upto sixth generations)
- Duly attested translated version (in English) of the above certificate issued by Ministry of Home Affairs, Suriname ☐
- Original Extract (Uittreksel) issued by respective Town Hall (Gemeente) in Netherlands showing both Parents name ☐
(should be less than 6 months old).

In case of Emergency Entry Visa: medical exigency/death of immediate family member

Copy of death of certificate of the deceased person or Doctor's Medical note on hospital/doctor's letterhead confirming patient details and indicating applicant's presence required

Copy of proof of relation of the applicant to the deceased such as copy of passport, birth certificate, marriage certificate etc

A self-declaration from the applicant justifying the reason for emergency travel along with documentary evidence.
