

NRI CERTIFICATE HOW TO APPLY

Type of Document	<p>NRI certificate is issued at the request of an Indian Passport holder (who is resident in the Netherlands) for the purpose of admission of his/ her son/ daughter/ ward in Colleges/ Universities in India under the NRI quota or for any other specific purpose subject to eligibility and fulfilment of necessary documentation requirements.</p>
How to apply	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Fill up the Miscellaneous form online.2. The applicants seeking NRI certificate services should see the below checklist for details: <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Please visit NRI certificate check list Link</u></p>3. Take Print-out of the online filled in application form. The form should be duly signed, photographs and necessary documents.4. Book an appointment (link)5. Book prepaid airway bill <u>DHL Express service</u> in the Netherlands for receiving processed documents. This should be submitted along with an A4 size self-addressed envelope6. Submit application alongwith necessary documents and prepaid A4 size self-addressed envelope at Embassy of India in The Hague (Ornajestraat 12, 2514 JB, The Hague).

Documents required	<p><u>LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A Miscellaneous form duly filled in and signed. 2. Declaration regarding the NRI status by the applicant in the Format of Declaration (For NRI Certificate) (Note: In support of his/ her declaration, the applicant is required to produce his/ her passport and Dutch Residence Permit Card (if the applicant is Dutch Residence Permit Card holder) in original and self-attested photocopy of passport page(s) containing Dutch Residence Permit/ Visa or self-attested photocopy of Dutch Residence Permit Card (if the applicant is Dutch Residence Permit Card holder) or passport page(s) containing immigration stamps confirming that the applicant did not reside in India for more than 180 days during the preceding financial year). 3. One photograph (5 cm * 5 cm) with white background and clear and complete face with shoulders visible. 4. Original Indian passport and copy of the same (first and last page). 5. Original Dutch residence permit card and copy of the same (front and back) <p>*Please be informed that there is no provision for making photocopies at the Embassy.</p>

Processing Time	05 to 07 days dispatch by courier only, no counter collection at the Embassy.

Q: What is the fee for service?

Q What is an NRI Certificate?

A: It is an official document issued by an Indian Embassy confirming that the applicant qualifies as a Non-Resident Indian (usually meaning they have stayed outside India for a defined period within a financial year). This status may be required for educational, financial, tax or legal purposes in India.

 TIP: Always bring multiple photocopies of all documents and ensure that names and addresses match across all your documents.
